AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2, SECTION 25 REGARDING THE AUTHORITY TO CALL SPECIAL MEETINGS THE CITY OF TIPTON, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2 was adopted in 1921; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen desires to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Tipton, Missouri ("Code") to allow for additional means of special meeting notifications;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Tipton, Missouri as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance 2, Section 25 shall be amended as follows:
Special meetings may be called by the Mayor or any two (2) members of the Board by filing a written request with the City Clerk, who shall thereupon prepare a notice of such special meeting, stating the time, date, place and object thereof, which notice shall be served personally upon each member of the Board or left at his/her usual place of residence at least twelve (12) hours before the time of the meeting, conforming with open meetings law as adopted. The City Clerk shall also, immediately upon receipt of the request for the meeting, to make a diligent effort to notify each member of the Board, either by telephone, email, text or other electronic means, of such special session.

The City Clerk shall make a diligent effort to notify those members of the media who customarily attend meetings of the Board of Aldermen of the special session, in the same manner described above.

Failure to comply with the requirements of this Section shall not invalidate any action taken at a special meeting of the Board of Aldermen.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
