## Notice to Bidders – Bid Specifications

### Sludge Removal

1. The City of Tipton is accepting sealed bids for the removal of approximately 300,000 gallons of bio solids from a concrete basin at the waste water treatment facility.
  - The bid shall include all labor, services and equipment.
  - The bid must be based using an umbilical cord system and a haul and spread option. The haul price should be based on a 1-7 mile trip. Bid a price per gallon for each option over 300,000 gallons.
  - Bidder is responsible for all testing and reports including, but not limited to: all required MDNR and USEPA testing during the cleanout detailing acres, gallons applied, total dry ton, agronomic loadings and trace metal loadings and certification of pathogen/vector attraction methods are met; MDNR and USEPA required pre-notification documents and final inspection report.
  - Each bid must include an every other year removal service price adjustment.
  - Each bid must contain 3 references for work done in the past five years.
2. Bidders are required to inspect the project site prior to submitting a bid. Questions regarding the project should be directed to Supt. of Public Works Jeff Koechner, 573.230.2761.
3. The sealed bid must be clearly marked “Sludge Removal”. Bids will be accepted until 10:30 a.m., Tuesday, October 26, 2021, and should be delivered to the City of Tipton, City Clerk, 101 E Moniteau St, PO Box 517, Tipton, MO 65081. After the bids are opened and reviewed for accuracy they will be submitted to the city council for approval at 6 p.m. on Monday, November 1, 2021.
4. The successful bidder shall have said project completed within 60 days of the award date.
5. A certificate of insurance must be provided to the City prior to work commencing. Limits shall be as follows:
  - a. General Liability - Coverage to include liability arising out from products-completed operations and liability assumed under an insured contract: not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence; not less than \$2,000,000 general aggregate.
  - b. Workmen's Compensation - Coverage meeting statutory limitations and employers liability of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence. Contractor shall agree to waive all rights of subrogation against the City of Tipton for any act, omission or condition of premises that the parties may be held liable by reason of negligence.

6. A bidder may withdraw any proposal at any time prior to the hour set for the closing of the bids, provided the request for withdrawal is signed in a manner identical with the proposal being withdrawn. 7. Invoices must be submitted to the City Clerk by 4 p.m. on the last Thursday of the month to be considered for approval at the City Council meeting.
8. The City of Tipton reserves the right to award the bid to the lowest, most responsive, responsible bidder and which is most advantageous to the City of Tipton. The City reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive any informalities or irregularities therein. All bidders must agree that such rejection shall be without liability on the part of the City for any damage or claim brought by any Bidder because of such rejections, nor shall the Bidders seek any recourse of any kind against the City because of such rejections. The filing of any bid in response to this invitation shall constitute an agreement of the Bidder to these conditions.
